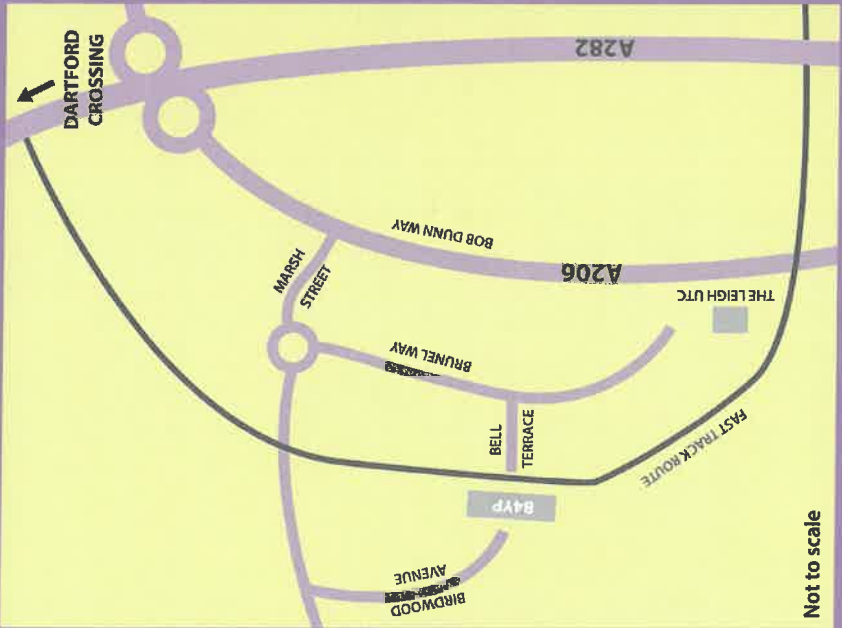

Sometimes life can be boring as a young person, but not if you live in Dartford as you have the **Bridge 4 Young People**. A Kent County Council funded youth centre for young people 8-19 (and up to 25 with additional needs) which offers a great place to meet your friends and take part in some fantastic activities and opportunities.



The centre is open throughout the week with a full programme of activities for all ages such as **The Duke of Edinburgh's Award** (see opposite page for details) and open sessions for 11-19s with chances to jam with our professional musicians, learning guitar or drums and even getting a track down on CD (part of separate workshop). In addition we have a fully equipped art room where you can express yourself to the full or just chill with friends over a game of pool or table tennis in our bright social area.



There are workshops and courses available for video making and animation, fitness, cooking plus much more. Please contact us for our current programme. Plus, now we have a special session for 8-12 year olds offering the same action packed programme of activities as other nights but for our younger members and is a wonderful way to start the weekend.



The centre offers a safe, caring place where young people can come and discuss any issue of concern for them with a team of professional workers who are able to help or signpost to more specialist services if needed. With fun packed novelty evenings and residentials throughout the year it is a great place to meet your friends and have some fun.

The Duke of Edinburgh's Award is a nationally recognised awards scheme for young people aged 14-25 years old. With Bronze, Silver and Gold levels, it sets to expand your skills and personal esteem by encouraging you to participate in four sections per level.

At bronze level you need to undertake three sections for an hour a week for 30 weeks plus an expedition.

**Skill** learn new skills such as photography, art, or even Circus skills.

**Physical** take on a new sporting/physical activity such as football, dance or even rock climbing.

**Volunteering** offer your services to non-profit making groups such as Cubs, Guides or even learn to be a first aider with The Red Cross.

**Expedition** take part in a two day walk over 26km with overnight stay under canvas, cooking and map reading your route.

The Bridge will help you arrange your placement for all sections and train you for your expedition so you are supported all the way.
