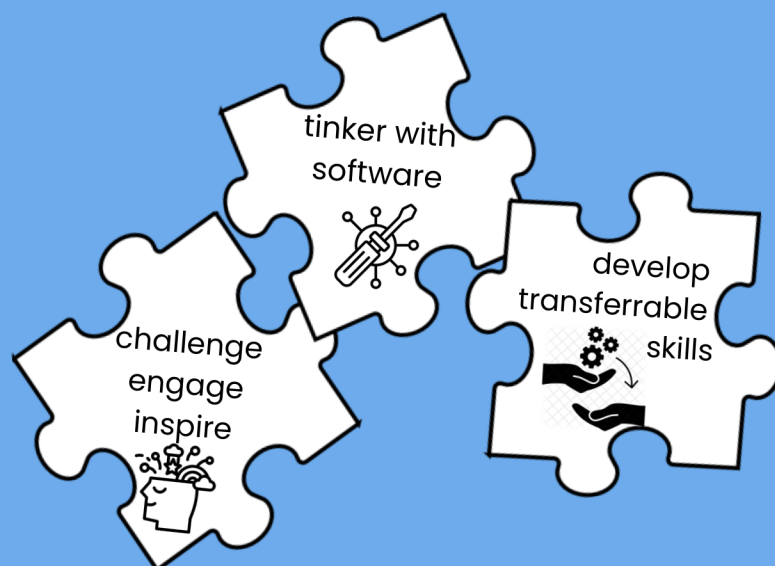


Fleetdown Curriculum Statement

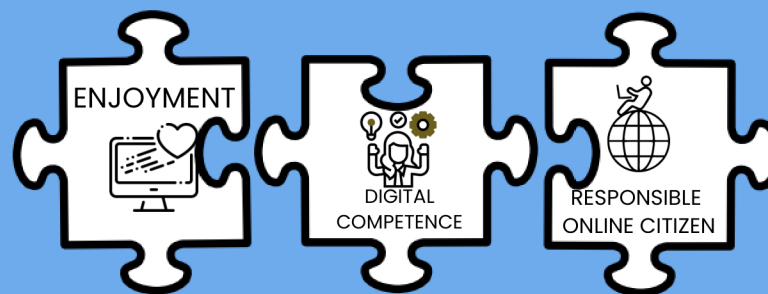
Computing



Purpose

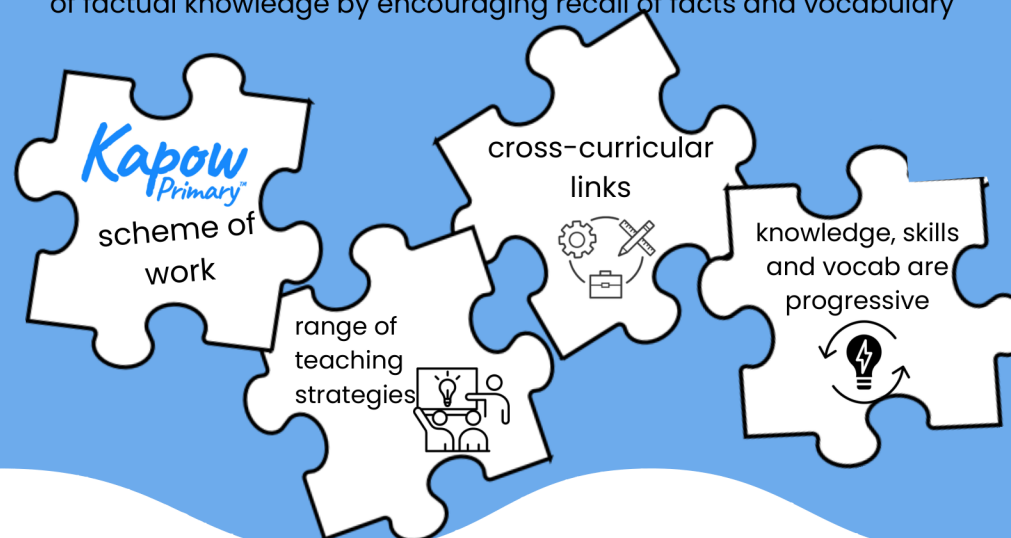


The computing curriculum at Fleetdown is intended to give children a sense of enjoyment around technology, providing opportunities to create, manage, organise and collaborate. Through our curriculum, we aim for pupils to not only be digitally literate, but also to develop the transferrable skills needed to be responsible online citizens.



Implementation

We use the Kapow! Primary scheme of work to deliver four computing lessons each term. These lessons are taught using a range of approaches including both unplugged and digital activities which support, stretch and challenge all learners. Sticky knowledge documents support children in building a foundation of factual knowledge by encouraging recall of facts and vocabulary.



Impact



Our computing curriculum is monitored formatively using our assessment policy. Children are able to think critically and make sound choices. They understand how to balance technology within their lives and how best to use technology to support their education and their life.
