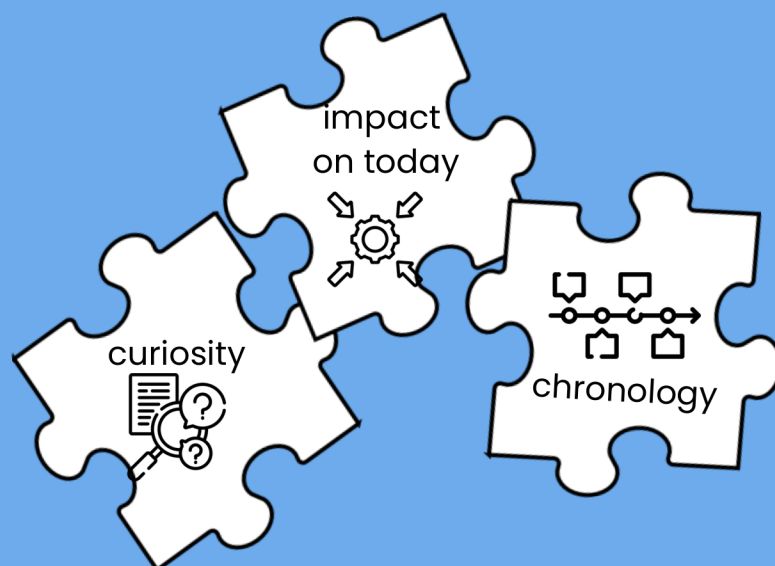


Fleetdown Curriculum Statement

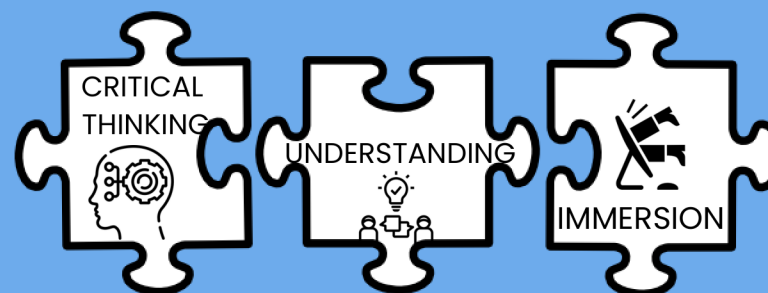
HISTORY



Purpose

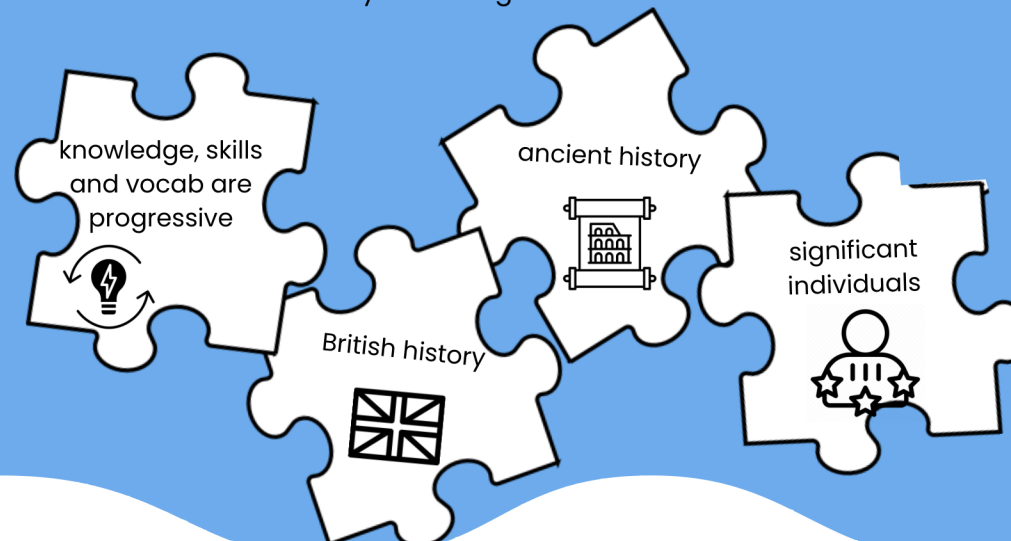

The children will know and understand significant aspects of history and the lives of significant individuals both in the past and today. Children will be taught to discuss ideas and think critically.

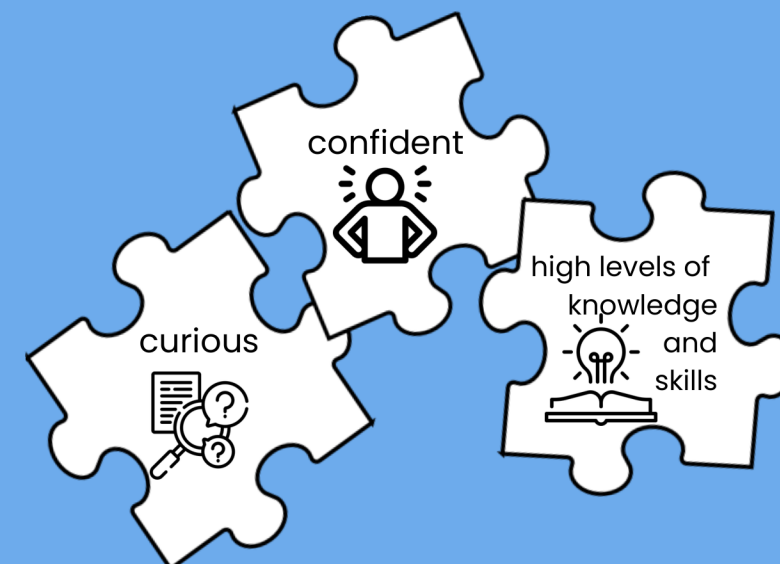


Implementation

Using our bespoke curriculum, history is taught in blocks. Each year group have a devoted topic name, where all foundation areas are taught in equal measure, allowing children to harness their historical skills as they progress through the school. In KS1, our curriculum is linked to the local area and in KS2 we look at British history and ancient history in chronological order. All lessons include key vocabulary, visited using sticky knowledge documents..



Impact
