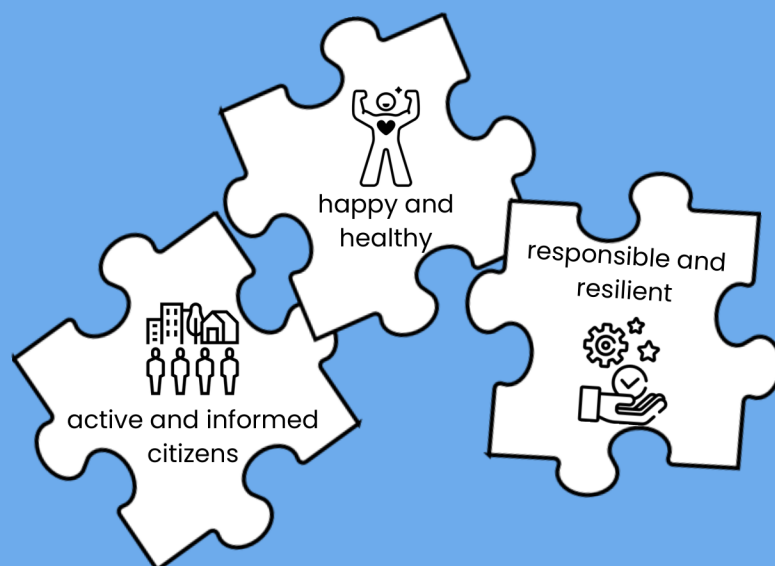

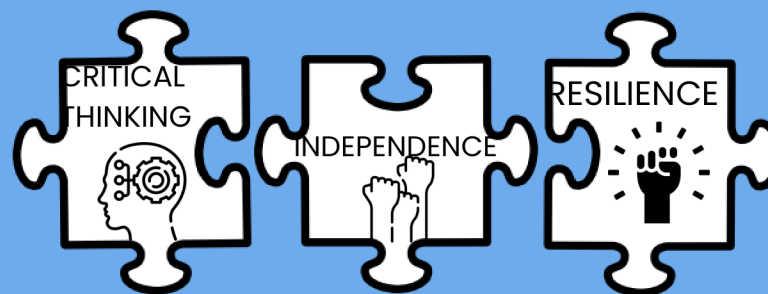

Purpose

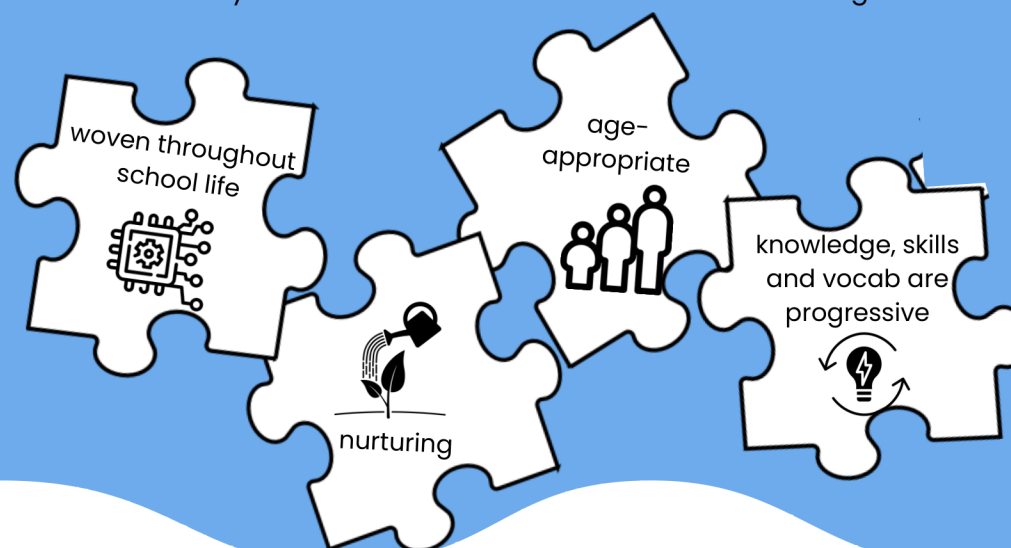

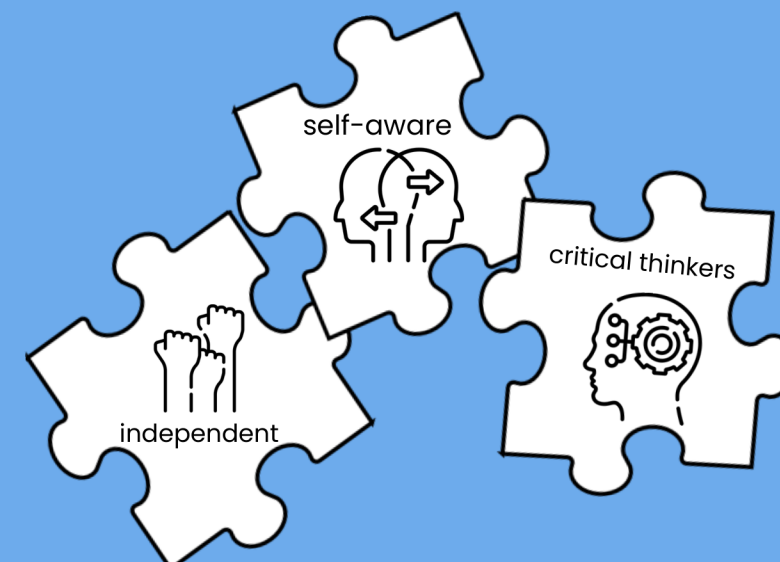


Implementation
